Noel plays the 12-string guitar open with no capo.

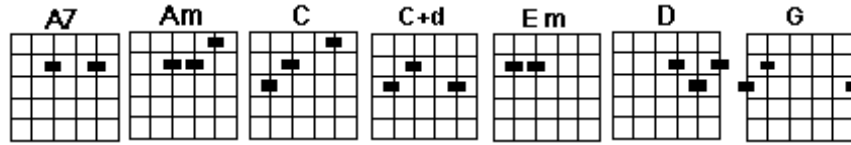
These **G** chords will match the recorded pitch even though

sheet music shows it in the key of **E** because the guitar

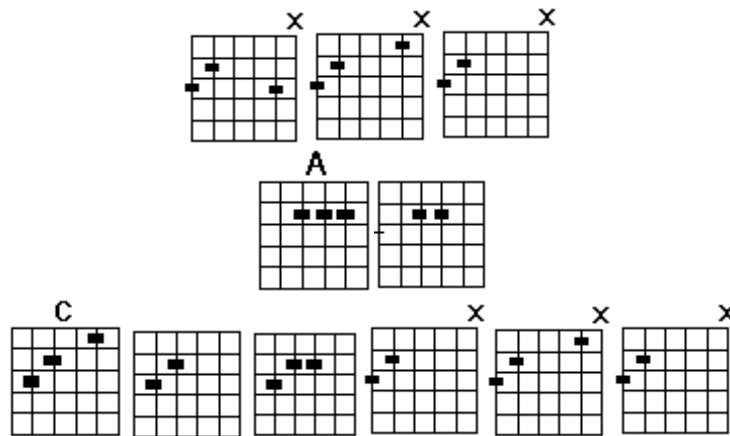
is tuned down one-and-one-half notes.

INTRO

These chords are not intended to be strummed. Instead, Noel uses an arpeggio picking pattern to achieve an overlapping downscale run, starting on the second string third fret and ending on the third string open. The phrase is repeated at the end of each verse and at the end of the bridge.
